1. General Environmental Review Project No: 190260 - W.O. 2020-1

Update:

Envirologic prepared materials for the December 17th meeting which will be held remotely via Zoom. Envirologic hosted the November meeting via Zoom. Envirologic attended the December committee meetings. Envirologic prepared transmittal letters for KCBRA and the City of Parchment for the Act 381 Work Plan for the 100 Island Ave. project.

Envirologic participated in development team conference call re: status, vapor intrusion discussion. Envirologic communicated with the developer's consultant and reviewed Grant Work Plan #3 related to additional VI assessment

Envirologic reviewed and commented on the developer's consultant's request to EGLE for a site specific VI criteria determination. Envirologic also reviewed Loan Work Plan #4 for additional dewatering analyses.

4. 315 E. Frank Street, Kalamazoo, MI

Project No: 200177 - W.O. 2020-3

Update:

Bogan Development is pursuing the acquisition of the above noted property with the intent of developing a multi-family, affordable housing community. Bogan funded a Phase I ESA which identified various Recognized Environmental Conditions (RECs). Envirologic has completed a KCBRA funded Phase II ESA which identified various contaminants above applicable state criteria. The site is a facility and will require a BEA. Findings were consistent with the findings from other downtown properties, i.e. fill, metals in soil and VOC's found at various locations in excess of state screening levels. Envirologic completed a BEA and Due Care Documentation for the project site.

2 & 10 Mills St., Kalamazoo, MI Project No: 200183 – W.O. 2020-4 Update:

Remi Harrington, the developer, Ruach Industries, has closed on the property. She approached the KCBRA in October for additional funding to allow her to update her Phase I ESA and complete the BEA and Due Care Documentation. The KCBRA approved funding and Envirologic has conducted the reinspection of the property and is finalizing these documents.

WHEREAS, the KCBRA with the help of staff at the Department of Planning and Community Development conducted a competitive bid process from October through November of 2012 and received seven (7) proposals from firms that were qualified to provide the contracted environmental services related to Brownfield redevelopment work; and

WHEREAS, the KCBRA Executive Committee reviewed the proposals and selected Envirologic Technologies as the best qualified to meet the needs of the KCBRA, based on the Consultant's previous work with Brownfield Redevelopment initiatives, EPA Brownfield Assessment grants and the Consultant's thorough understanding of the KCBRA's functions from previous work with the KCBRA; and

WHEREAS, the KCBRA has adopted the recommendation by the Executive Committee of Envirologic Technologies as the best qualified because they possesses the experience, expertise and training to provide project management and environmental consulting services for the KCBRA on a project-by-project basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and promises contained in this Contract, the parties agree as follows:

SECTION I. THE CONSULTANT'S DUTIES

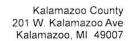
